



CITY OF SCOTTSDALE – OFFICE OF THE MAYOR
Emergency Proclamation
No. 11-3-2022

WHEREAS, the Scottsdale City Charter, Scottsdale Revised Code, Chapter 10, and Arizona Revised Statutes §26-311, authorize the Mayor of the City of Scottsdale, Arizona, to declare a local emergency under appropriate circumstances; and

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2021, Mayor David D. Ortega issued a proclamation declaring a state of emergency within the City due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Said Declaration of Emergency was approved by the Scottsdale City Council on January 12, 2021 and in effect until terminated by the Mayor or City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Scottsdale has continued its return to business as usual while recovery from the pandemic is well underway; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic no longer presents conditions in the City of Scottsdale that rise to the level of a local emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, David D. Ortega, as Mayor of the City of Scottsdale, County of Maricopa, State of Arizona, by virtue of the authority vested in me do hereby proclaim and declare that the emergency proclamation dated January 12, 2021 and any subsequent emergency proclamations relating to COVID-19 are **rescinded** effective November 4, 2022.
