1. Half-size set (12"x18" or 11"x17") of the approved sewer improvement plans;
2. An extension diagram, or plan, (8.5"x11") showing adjacent properties and their frontage dimension along the sewer extension (separately indicate dimensions for the following extension segments: segments without any frontage e.g. within the City right of way; those with multiple frontages e.g. a cul-de-sac segment);
3. Contractor's construction cost estimate (must provide three (3) formal itemized bids);
4. Engineering costs (provide copies of paid invoices from the engineering company);
5. Itemized list of all other actual and/or anticipated completed project costs including permits. For actual costs already paid, provide corresponding receipts.

Purpose Statement :

The expansion of the City of Scottsdale's sewer collection system facilitates the protection and improvement of groundwater quality and allows us to capture a valuable water resource for reuse in a desert environment. The expansion of the sewer collection system supports our mission to be good stewards of all water resources.

General Information:

Per City Code Section 49-227, single family residential property owners that are required to extend public sewer lines to their property may be eligible for the city participation.

Provisions related to payback agreements and city participation are set forth in the City Code. The City's total reimbursement current practice is to accept a participation assignment of up to \$250,000 if City funds are available. Prior to a formal agreement for City participation, a requestor must meet the criteria of Scottsdale Revised Code 49-227. City Code Section 49-227 provides that if funding is available, it will be on a "first come first served" basis. Therefore, the City cannot confirm that funds will be available until an application is received and processed in accordance with the rules and regulations and all criteria have been met.

Important Notes on this Initial Determination Process:

- This form, including the items listed above, must be submitted to the Water Resources Department after the plans are approved and signed by the City Development Services, or designee, and **no later than 60 calendar days after the issuance of sewer construction permits.**
- Two applicant signatures/dates are required on this form, initial submissions signature/date and a signature/date acknowledging acceptance of the Water Resources Department estimated eligible and available participation amount. Water Resources Department has 60 calendar days to sign and return this form once submitted by the applicant. The applicant has 180 calendar days to return the form with the second signature/date, accepting the estimated participation amount. If the signed form is not returned by the applicant within 180 calendar days, the offer of funds will be considered withdrawn and the funds will pass to the next eligible Developer application in chronological order.
