

- · Qualification based process for selecting contractors
- Provided for under ARS Title 34
- Commonly used for unusual projects or those with specific characteristics that require special experience
- · Two step process of contract award:
 - Preconstruction phase services (tonight)
 - · Contractor works with designer to find efficiencies
 - · Contractor develops construction cost estimate
 - Construction phase services (October 22)
 - "Guaranteed Maximum Price" established
 - Initiates construction process
