

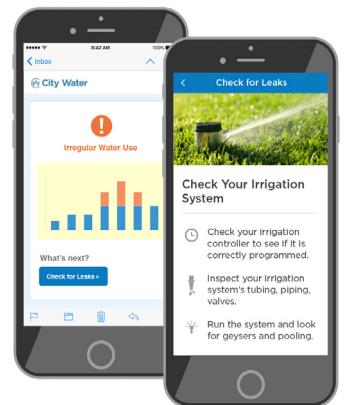


## Conservation Starts With You

In order to protect this precious resource, Scottsdale Water wants to empower customers and residents to take action **TODAY** in order to secure our water for the **FUTURE**.

**By taking advantage of Scottsdale Water’s Conservation Programs, you can become a Water Warrior in no time:**

- Sign up for [WaterSmart](#). Customers can see their water use in easy-to-read graphics, download their water use data, and sign-up for water use notifications.
- Qualify for incentive [rebates](#). Customers may receive a rebate for installing WaterSense labeled products or yard conversions:
  - Toilet, smart irrigation controllers, removing summer grass or pool removal.
- Receive a free Outdoor Water Efficiency Check, Large Landscape Consultation or Water Audit. Email [waterconservation@scottsdaleaz.gov](mailto:waterconservation@scottsdaleaz.gov) for more information.



**Homeowners** can sign up for an Outdoor Water Efficiency Check where a Water Conservation Specialist will go to their home and help set their irrigation controller (timer) appropriately for their plant material.

**Businesses and homeowner associations** with large landscapes can request a landscape consultation. The consultation focuses on reviewing and analyzing outdoor water use and provides recommendations on reducing water use.

**Businesses** such as restaurants, hotels, and medical facilities can request a free Indoor Water Audit. The audit focuses on reviewing and analyzing indoor water use and provides recommendations on reducing water use.
