SHALL THE COUNCIL'S PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE SCOTTSDALE CITY CHARTER RELATING TO THE DATES FOR HOLDING THE CITY'S PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTIONS AND WHEN THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBER TERMS COMMENCE BE APPROVED?
A "yes" vote shall have the effect of correcting outdated language in the City Charter by clarifying that the city's primary and general elections are held concurrently with the State's primary and general elections, in conformance with State law, and that the terms of the mayor and each member of the council shall commence at the first regular meeting of the Council in January of the year following their election, in conformance with current practice.
