

Oil & Acrylic Painting Supplies List / Instructor: Robin Oden

- **Artist Smock or Apron (optional)**
- **Color Wheel (strongly suggested)**
- **(2) Primed Canvases- 14" x 18" or Larger**
- **Canvas Paper Pad (10 sheets or more)- 9" x 12" (for painting practice)**
- **Sketch pad - 9" x 12"**
- **Paint palette (for mixing paints)**
- **No.2 pencil and separate eraser**
- **Oil OR Acrylic paints: (I recommend Windsor & Newton, Holbein and Liquitex brands- whichever colors are closest on the following list;
Cadmium Red Med, Alizarin Crimson, French Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean Blue, Violet, Burnt Sienna, Vandyke Brown, Payne's Gray, Cadmium Yellow light, Viridian Green, Sap Green, Titanium White, Ivory Black**
- **Paint brushes- * Note there are different brushes for Oils and Acrylics
Bring your assortment including: 2" Flat house paint brush,
#4 Round, #8 Round, #4 Filbert, #8 Filbert, #8 Flat**
- **(1 piece) Sandpaper- 100 grit or close**
- **Odorless Turpentine or Mineral Spirits (only for oil painting)**
- **3 Closed Containers for Turpentine(for oil painters) OR
3 Containers for water (for acrylic painters)**
- **Rags, paper towels**
