Equity and Representation

- Children with disabilities and learning disorders (middle school)
 - Need same opportunities as other students
- Children from immigrant families and first generation students facing language barriers do not have role models
- Children that have been abused or neglected
 - Make process more affordable, targeting secondary education
- Social media posts may not be effective at reaching disadvantaged groups.
 - Maybe partner with school districts like SUSD and place flyers at grocery stores, libraries, etc
 - Focus on prominent individuals including teachers and parents
 - Speak at teacher meetings to raise awareness
- Partner with nonprofits to offer tutoring and other supportive services
- Reach out to SUSD middle school principals and communicate with Indian Reservation (partner with Youth Council on Indian Reservation)
- Scottsdale area is generally economically well-off and does not include many low income and underprivileged students

Practical Education

- Pamphlet (informative) created using Canva to focus on providing practical knowledge that many schools do not offer
- Interviewing experts in financial literacy and job seeking to know "what is it like to have a job?"
- Contact SUSD for announcements and flyers
- Provide links to sources and information on the City website
- Host seminars on practical education (ex. Interviewing techniques) through platforms such as Zoom

College/Future Preparation

- Action items:
 - Timeline of checkpoints throughout high school based on age
 - Document to hand out at Youth Town Hall or available online (worksheet)
 - Have former SMYC members talk about their experience with college applications.
 - Documents for list of scholarships, extracurricular opportunities, tips for test taking, and essay writing
 - EVIT program at SUSD
 - Check if resources exist by visiting schools to check if this is already being done
