## ORDINANCE NO. 2738

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCOTTSDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING SCOTTSDALE REVISED CODE, CHAPTER 16, ARTICLE X, SECTION 16-353(A), RELATED TO SOLICITING EMPLOYMENT AND ADVERTISEMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Scottsdale, Maricopa County, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1. Section 16-353(a) of Article X, Chapter 16, of the Scottsdale Revised Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (a) No person, except as otherwise provided in section 16-354 and except the display of banners which identify an event conducted by a nonprofit organization which the city council finds is of general community interest and is not displayed more than ten (10) days PURSUANT TO SCOTTSDALE REVISED CODE SECTION 47-72(3) AND SECTION 8.540 OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SCOTTSDALE, ORDINANCE 455, AS AMENDED, shall on any street offer for sale, solicit the employment of or announce by any means, the availability of any goods, wares, merchandise, services or facilities, or solicit patronage for or advertise any show, exhibition, entertainment, tour, excursion, sight-seeing trip or real estate.
- (b) No person who is visible or audible to any person on any street shall, in a loud, boisterous, raucous, offensive or insulting manner, offer for sale, solicit the purchase of, announce the availability of, or solicit the employment of any goods, wares, merchandise, services or facilities, or solicit patronage for or advertise any show, exhibition, entertainment, tour, excursion, sight-seeing trip or real estate.
- (c) No person shall have, bear, wear or carry upon any street, any advertising banner, flag, board, sign, transparency, wearing apparel or other device advertising, publicly announcing or calling attention to any goods, wares, merchandise, or commodities, or to any place of business, occupation, show, exhibition, event or entertainment. The provisions of this subsection do not apply to the wearing of apparel without remuneration for doing so or business identification on wearing apparel.
