The court having considered options for better achieving swift fair justice in the application and approval of community restitution per the court policy; and

**WHEREAS** A.R.S. § 13-824, and 28-1604 provides that notwithstanding any other law, if a monetary obligation is imposed on a defendant at sentencing and the court finds the defendant is unable to pay all or part of the monetary obligation, on the defendant's request the court may allow the defendant to perform community restitution in lieu of the payment for all or part of the monetary obligation; and,

**WEHEREAS** with the approval of the Presiding Judge the court has established a policy on the eligibility of community restitution.

**IT IS ORDERED** delegating the review and authorization of eligibility for community restitution in lieu of fines and fees to court staff.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that court staff will adhere to and apply the guidelines and instructions put forth in the court policy regarding eligibility for community restitution in lieu of fines and fees as approved by the Presiding Judge, subject to judicial review if requested.
