# **Subject of Interpretation:**

Clarifying those circumstances under which signs placed in the public right-of-way or on public property that would be exempt under Section 8.102 III

### **Zoning Ordinance Section Number:**

ARTICLE VII. SIGN REQUIREMENTS SECTION 8.102 III

#### Title of Section:

Requirement of Conformity Section 8.102 III No sign shall be placed in the right-of-way or on public property, except for traffic management, street name or other signs erected by a governmental entity for a governmental purpose.

### Cause for Interpretation:

To insure the uniform application and enforcement of the City's Sign Ordinance.

## Interpretation:

Scottsdale's Amended Zoning Ordinance at Sec. 8.102 III allows the placement of signs on public property or in right-of-way if the signs are for traffic management, street name or erected by a government for a governmental purpose. Where the City has entered into contractual obligations such as, but not limited to, a lease, development agreement, license or special event permit for the use of right-of-way or public property and where the City has relinquished control of the public property, or right-of-way any sign that is placed in the public right-of-way or on the public property is not in violation of Section 8.102 III.
