

Arizona State Retirement System - Return to Work Program

City of Scottsdale

SB1095 was signed by Governor Hull and became effective on May 15, 2002. SB 1095 conforms state law to changes in federal law resulting from the passage of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001 (EGTRRA).

The law repeals the scheduled June 30, 2003, cut-off of the Return to Work Program. The Return to Work Program allows all Arizona State Retirement System (ASRS) retired members who have achieved normal retirement to return to work full-time one year after terminating employment. The member continues to receive all retirement benefits, but does not make any retirement or Long-term Disability (LTD) contributions to the ASRS and does not accrue any additional benefits in the ASRS, nor is the member eligible for LTD benefits.

This notice authorizes the Payroll department to set the following employee up with a retirement code of 05-RTW Retiree No retirement. This retirement code will not deduct ASRS contributions (Plan, System or LTD) and requires written notification from Human Resources for any retirement changes.
