### Supplies:

#### Colored Pencils

Brand recommendations:

Prismacolor Pencils

Faber-Castell Polychromos

I would recommend getting a 24 pack or more to start.

#### Paper

You can use colored pencils on almost any paper. I would stay away from regular printer paper though as it is too thin.

Papers I would recommend include:

Strathmore Bristol (Thick, smooth cardstock)

Strathmore Bristol Vellum (Textured paper. Has more tooth than the smooth Bristol)

Mixed Media Paper

Drawing Paper

Watercolor paper if you want to combine

colored pencils with watercolor

#### Miscellaneous Supplies

Pencil

Pencil sharpener

Eraser (Can be plastic or kneaded)

#### Optional Supplies

Strathmore Toned Tan paper, Toned Gray, or Toned Blue. This is a fun option if you want to try other paper colors besides white.

Colored Pencils look great with other mediums. Feel free to bring Watercolor Pencils, Micron Pens, and alcohol markers for a mixed media look.
